What is Day Camp?

Samford Day Camp is Moreton Rivers Presbytery's annual primary school camp held at Samford Valley Community Church during the June/July school holidays.

Unlike a regular camp, as the name suggests, Day Camp only runs during the day, so campers get to experience all the fun of camp with the security of sleeping at home.

Day Camp truly is an all-ages event. While our campers are limited to children from Prep-Grade 6, we have a leadership training program for Grades 7&8, and anyone from Grade 9-99 can join us as small group leaders and volunteer helpers.

So, it's only during the day?

Yup! The programmed activities will run 9:30am-3:45pm, with busses available from various churches to transport campers, fusion, and leaders to site. Leaders will be onsite from 8:45am- 4:15pm for those wishing to go straight to site.

Everyone attending camp will need to bring a hat, water bottle and any food they will need for a big day of activity. Sun-safe clothing and closed in shoes will need to be worn.

What do you do at Day Camp?

We have a range of activities at Day Camp, some traditional camp activities, like fire cooking, and others that are just for fun. All of our campers and Fusion will also enjoy our rock climbing and bungee trampoline adventure activities.

Day Camp will start and end each day with a worship rally where we will sing worship songs and talk about the day's theme.

What is Fusion?

Fusion is an intentional leadership program for Grade 7s and 8s. It is the step between camper and leader where participants will learn valuable leadership skills and get to put them in to practice as the week goes on.

Fusion will still participate in the rallies and adventure activities with the rest of camp.

Who can help?

One of the best parts of Day Camp is seeing the whole church come together. Older youth (grade 9+), young adults, and volunteers of all ages are what we need to make Day Camp happen.

We'd love people of all ages to come along for as much of camp as they can, leading small groups, running activities, or simply being on site to help.
